Emergency Cash Grants for College Students Impacted By COVID-19

U.S. Secretary of Education Betsy DeVos has authorized direct emergency cash grants to college students whose lives and education have been disrupted by the coronavirus outbreak. This funding is available through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) II Coronavirus Response Relief Supplemental Appropriation Acts (CRRSAA), signed into law by President Donald J. Trump on December 27, 2020.

The Emergency Cash Grants are to be used for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the coronavirus such as course materials and technology needed to participate in online classes as well as food, housing, health care, and childcare. These funds are to serve and ensure learning continues during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Grant amounts will be calculated based on a students Expected Family Contribution (EFC).
